CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (North Well) through a drilled well, pump and stockwater troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 28, T. 33N., R. 63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 31, T. 33N., R. 63E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 69° 55' W., a distance of 16,322.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0218 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 2,000 sheep
Period of use, from March 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 7, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 160 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a gasoline motor and Jensen Jack pump, thence the water is conveyed via a 4" diameter pipeline to a 2,000 gallon storage tank and 60' long watering troughs where 300 head of of cattle and 2000 sheep water within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 28, T. 33N., R. 63E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
