CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Liza Jane Well) through a drilled well, pump and stockwater troughs for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, T.31N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 36, T.31N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 80° 29' W., a distance of 16,750.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Loyd Sorensen and Alta H. Sorensen, Von Loyd Sorensen and Marian Sorensen, Kenneth G. Jones and Lorna S. Jones

Post-office address: Elko, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use, from March 1st to November 30th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 7, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a drilled well, unknown depth, 6" diameter casing, equipped with a gasoline engine driven Jensen Jack pump, thence the water is conveyed via a 2" pipeline to a 500 gallon stockwater tank where 500 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 34, T.31N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
