CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Winter Creek Well) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T.37N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 24 bears N. 45° 15' 00" W., a distance of 2,440.56 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: McCormick Brothers
Post-office address: Deeth, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.028 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle and 100 horses
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 10, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well 191 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a windmill thence conveyed to a 20 foot by 2-1/2 foot deep tank by 20 feet of 1-1/4 inch pipeline located within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 24, T.37N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., where 800 head of cattle and 100 horses are watered.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
