CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Spencer Pitcher, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Camino Well) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T. 19N., R. 48E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 4, T. 18N., R. 48E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 06° 27' 20" E., a distance of 8,597.3 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States Government, Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management

Post-office address: Battle Mountain, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.009 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 575 head of cattle and 29 horses

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: October 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted by means of a drilled well 186 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a windmill and storage tank, thence conveyed to three troughs located within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, T. 19N., R. 48E., M.D.B.&M., where 575 head of cattle and 29 horses are watered.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
