CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Louise Lear, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Phalen Well) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 5, T.26N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Section 5 bears N. 55° 37' 31" E., a distance of 1,033.30 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lear Ranches
Post-office address: Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 325 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 18, 1984

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted by means of a drilled well 300 feet deep, 6 inch casing, 240 feet of 3-1/2 inch column piping, via a pump jack, thence conveyed to three tanks located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 5, T.26N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., where 325 head of cattle are watered.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
