CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Section 12 Well) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwatering and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 12, T.33N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 12 bears N. 34 0 40' E., a distance of 1,260.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0074 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 4, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 390 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a 2-1/2 inch cylinder pump, thence conveyed to the place of use which consists of two steel troughs and an overflow storage pond. Water is to be used for domestic purposes and stockwatering purposes to serve 500 head of cattle located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 12, T.33N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
