CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17, T.38N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 17 bears N. 31° 34' 10" W., a distance of 1,353.72 feet

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Wells, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.003 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 24, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 100 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a windmill thence conveyed by means of 5 feet of 3/4 inch pipeline to a trough used for stockwatering purposes. The place of use is located within the W 1/2 W 1/2 of Section 17, T.38N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., where 100 head of cattle are watered.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
