CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 27, T. 32N., R. 45E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 27 bears S. 22° 19' 28" W., a distance of 2,843.50 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.013 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.122 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 11, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 190 feet deep, 10" diameter hole, via a 3/4 HP submersible pump through a distribution system which serves office rest rooms and truck garage rest room and steam cleaner outlet within portions of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27, T. 32N., R. 45E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
