CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Crazy Tom Well) through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 25, T.6N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 34, T.6N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 86° 45' W., a distance of 12,239.0 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Zimmerman Ranching Corp.  
Post-office address Round Mountain, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation December 20, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 200' deep, 8" diameter casing, equipped with a portable Jensen Jack pump and 5 HP gasoline engine, thence the water is conveyed to an 8,000 gallon storage tank and 500 gallon stockwatering trough where 200 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25, T.6N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
