CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 26, T.36N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 26 bears S. 12° 13' W., a distance of 1,429.2 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Orville Floyd Lynch
Post-office address: Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.02 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.5475 million gallons annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 12, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 100 feet deep, 6" casing, equipped with a 1-1/4 HP submersible pump and totalizing meter No. 5345515, thence the water is conveyed through a distribution system which serves five (5) mobile homes within portions of the W 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 26, T.36N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
