CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edward A. Melka, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Melka Well) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) Section 19, T.20N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 19, bears N. 03° 52' 20" W., a distance of 1,525.3 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0016 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 300 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a 14 foot windmill, thence conveyed by pipeline to two 3' x 9' troughs located within Lot 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) of Section 19, T.20N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., to water 50 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
