CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Richard Norman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Mining and Milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.22S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.
 or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said
 Section 9 bears S. 49°42'20" W., a distance of
 304.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of
 Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation: 0.50 c.f.s., but not to exceed
 244.0 acre-feet annually
 Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 700 feet deep, 12 inch casing, via a 25 H.P. submersible pump to a 50,000 gallon storage tank and a storage pond, thence through a distribution system to a sand and gravel operation with travel trailers, shop, and office located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9; E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 16; W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 15; all in T.22S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of Permit 17656 Certificate 12630, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 17656 Certificate 12630.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
