CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Twin Springs through a developed spring and natural channel for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, T.29N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 36, T.29N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 62° 15' E., a distance of 6,610.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Loyd Sorensen
Post-office address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.027 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 3,000 sheep
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 7, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a developed spring which is cleaned annually to assure flow to the natural channel where 300 head of cattle and 3,000 sheep water within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, T.29N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
