CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

an Underground Source (Lincoln Well No. 1)

through a drilled well, pump, windmill and stockwatering troughs for

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22, T.19N.,

R.48E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the SE corner of Section

24, T.19N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 76° 51' 20" E., a distance of 14,032.6 feet

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Austin, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 19, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a drilled well, 105' deep, 8" diameter casing, equipped

with a submersible pump, 12 H.P. generator and windmill, thence the water is

conveyed to a 8' x 16' storage tank and an 18' x 3-1/2' round stockwatering

trough where 1,000 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 22,

T.19N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed).

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
