CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Bean Flat Well) through a drilled well, windmill and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 4, T.19N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 4 bears N. 38° 24' 25" W., a distance of 2,683.2 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 19, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 34' deep, 6" diameter casing, equipped with a windmill, thence the water is conveyed to two 10' x 4' x 3' stockwatering troughs where 1,000 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 4, T.19N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
