CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bruce L. Rice, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Devil's Canyon Spring through a developed spring and distribution system for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 8, T.1S., R. 52E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 36, T.1N., R. 51 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 40° 31' 30" W., a distance of 8,764.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0067 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 25 horses

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 7, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from a developed spring via a collection sump at the spring outlet where 1,000 head of cattle and 25 horses water within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 8, T.1S., R. 52E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed).

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
