CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Madeline Gartland, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Government Tract 43-D, Section 9, T.16S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Government Tract 43-D bears S. 84° 19' 58" E., a distance of 1294.99 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.037 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.49 million gallons annual
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 24, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 100 feet deep, 8" diameter casing, equipped with a 3 H.P. submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed to a 525 gallon tank and distribution system which serves 18 mobile homes and a single family residence all located within Government Tracts 43-C, 43-D of Section 9, T.16S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M (Lots 71 and 94 of Indian Springs Pecan Groves Subdivision.)

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
