CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Louis V. Rinaldi, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Warm Springs through a spring box, pipeline and reservoir for Commercial and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 3, T.41N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 3 bears N. 28° 31' W., a distance of 1,446.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Louis V. and Mary M. Rinaldi
Post-office address Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.045 c.f.s., but not to exceed 10.512 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 14, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a spring box, pipeline and reservoir, thence conveyed to the place of use for commercial and domestic purposes to serve a hot tub, greenhouse and residence located within the S 1/2 N 1/2 of Section 4 and the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 5, T.41N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 28566, Certificate 10780 shall not exceed 10.512 million gallons annually.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
