CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Claude E. Hunter, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Anderson Spring through a diversion pond, pipeline and troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 11, T.11N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 11 bears S. 60° 15' 00" E., a distance of 3,982.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1600 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 15, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a diversion pond thence conveyed via 11,500 feet of 2 inch plastic pipe to three 14' x 3.8' x 18" troughs and a pond where 1600 head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 12, and NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 13, all in T.11N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
