CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, U.S. Bureau of Land Management, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Lindsay Creek Well) through a drilled well, pump and troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 4, T.27N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 4 bears N. 43° 26' 10" W., a distance of 2,368.19 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States Bureau of Land Management
Post-office address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 318 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 6 inch casing, equipped with a gasoline engine driven Aermotor pump, thence the water is conveyed via 82 feet of 1-1/2 inch pipe to a 4700 gallon round trough and a 700 gallon rectangular trough where 318 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 4, T.27N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
