

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source ("Vance" Well) through a drilled well, windmill and stockwater trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 31, T.35N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31 bears S. 45 00' 00" E., a distance of 141.42 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Elko Land and Livestock Co.
Post-office address: Carlin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.006 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 3, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 151.5 feet deep, 6-5/8 inch casing, equipped with a windmill and pump jack, thence conveyed via 18 feet of 1-1/2 inch pipeline to a 21 foot wide by 21 inch deep trough where 200 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 31, T.35N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
