CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lower Deadman Spring through an earth berm and pond for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 21, T.39N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 19, T.39N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 86° 04' W., a distance of 12,377.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lands of Sierra, Inc.
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.027 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 28, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of an existing earthen berm which impounds a small stream in a natural channel which creates a pond where 1,000 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21, T.39N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
