CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Warm Spring through a concrete forebay and pipeline for Power Generation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 8 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) Section 31, T.34N., R.59E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 31 bears S. 51° 53' 32" W., a distance of 1,913.88 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 3, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a concrete forebay, 10 feet by 12 feet by 12 feet, thence conveyed via 13,460 feet of 24 inch ductile iron penstock buried 3 to 12 feet deep to the place of use for Power Generation purposes located within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24, T.34N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M. The water is then returned to the natural channel. This certificate is for non-consumptive use.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
