CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and stockwater trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 17, T.37N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 17 bears N. 82° 40' 36" E., a distance of 1,411.04 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James M. and Edward H. Smiley

Post-office address Deeth, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 7, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 595 feet deep, 6 inch casing to 468 feet, via a submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed by 150 feet of 1-1/4 inch pipeline to a 8 foot diameter by 24 inch deep stockwatering trough where 200 head of cattle water within the W 1/2 E 1/2 and the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 17, T.37N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
