CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bureau of Land Management, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Izzenhood No. 2 Well) through a drilled well, windmill and stockwater trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, T.34N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 31, T.35N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 58° 10' 57" E., a distance of 15,360.98 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States Bureau of Land Management
Post-office address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.009 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 30 deer
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 100 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a windmill and 5,000 gallon storage tank, thence conveyed to a 1200 gallon trough where 300 head of cattle and 30 deer water within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
