CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Toano Well No. 3) through a drilled well, pump and trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 14, T.39N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 14 bears S. 68° 47' W., a distance of 2,214 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place, where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator - Bureau of Land Management
Post-office address - Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.024 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 23, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 418 feet deep, 10 inch casing, via a pump jack, thence conveyed to an 8,000 gallon stockwatering tank where 1,000 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14, T.39N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
