CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Wilkins Seeding Well #1) through a drilled well, pump and trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 32, T.42N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 32 bears N. 75 00' E., a distance of 254.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows: Name of appropriator: Bureau of Land Management, Lands of Sierra, Inc., and the Department of Interior; Post-office address: Reno, Nevada; Amount of appropriation: 0.018 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle; Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year; Date of priority of appropriation: June 23, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 223 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, via a pump jack, thence conveyed to an 8,000 gallon stockwater tank where 800 head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 32, T.42N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
