CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and stockwater trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T.39N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 9 bears S. 45° 18' 54" W., a distance of 971.10 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Glaser Land and Livestock
Post-office address: Halleck, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.005 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 170 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 11, 1983

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 148 feet deep, 6-5/8 inch casing, via a submersible pump, thence conveyed to a stockwatering trough with dimensions 4-1/2 feet by 2-1/2 feet by 37 feet where 170 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 9, T.39N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
