CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Andrew Boundy, Former Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sharpe Creek through an earth dam and pond for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 14, T.24N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of Section 32, T.24N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 40 0 45' W., a distance of 27,300.0 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.012 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 2,000 sheep
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 23, 1919

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of an earth dam and reservoir where 2,000 sheep water within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 14, T.24N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed).

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
