CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. J. Vasey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Canyon Creek Well No. 1) through a drilled well, pump and stockwater troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 4, T.45N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 32, T.46N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 89 0 31' W., a distance of 6751.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 24, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 10 inch casing, equipped with a submersible pump, thence conveyed via 2300 feet of 1-1/4 inch PVC pipeline to a 1-1/2 foot x 4 foot x 14 foot trough and a 3 foot x 20 foot half-round trough where 500 head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 32, T.46N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
