CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, windmill and stockwater troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 31, T.46N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 8, T.45N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 18 0 59' 06" E., a distance of 12,172.55 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Victor Land & Livestock Co.
Post-office address: Logan, Utah
Amount of appropriation: 0.025 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 1, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 6 inch casing, equipped with a windmill driven pump, thence conveyed via 10 feet of 2 inch pipeline to a trough 24 feet in diameter and 18 inches deep and an overflow pond where 800 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 31, T.46N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
