CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, windmill and stockwater trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T.37N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of Section 13, T.37N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 65 0 09' 54" E., a distance of 2958.26 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.013 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 3, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 184 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a windmill driven pump, thence conveyed to a 6000 gallon trough where 500 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, T.37N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
