CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Uhalde, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Mining purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) Section 24, T.29N., R.47E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Section corner of said Section 24 bears N. 19° 05' 26" E., a distance of 870.52 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.84 c.f.s., but not to exceed 73.584 million gallons seasonally
Period of use, from April 10th to December 10th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 18, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 420 feet deep, 16 inch and 12 inch diameter casing, thence conveyed by 60 feet of 8 inch pipeline and 120 feet of 4 inch pipeline to the millsite for mining and milling purposes within Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) of Section 24, T.29N., R.47E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
