CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John G. Murdock, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring through an underground tank and pipeline for Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 20, T.39N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Section 20 bears N. 87° 23' 32" E., a distance of 1,643.18 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John G. Murdock
Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0011 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.26 million gallons seasonally
Period of use, from April 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 17, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of 1,000 feet of PVC pipe and a 100 gallon underground storage tank, thence conveyed to the place of use for domestic purposes to serve shrubs and trees located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, T.39N., R.46E., M.D.B. &M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
