CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. J. Vasey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Maiden Spring No. 2 through a developed spring and pond for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 3, T.45N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 3 bears N. 72° 30' E., a distance of 105.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation March 13, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a 4' x 4' concrete spring box, thence conveyed via a 1-1/4" diameter pipe to a stock pond where 200 head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 3, T.45N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 36964, therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 36964.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
