CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George G. Assuras, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from The Truckee River (Steamboat Ditch-Hunter Creek Treatment Plant) through dams, ditches and pipelines for Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31 bears S. 62° 04' E., a distance of 3,195.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

- Name of appropriator: Sierra Pacific Power Company
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 40.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 28959.1 acre-feet annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation: See Truckee River Agreement

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted by means of existing dams, open ditches, existing pumping stations, via pipelines to the Hunter Creek Treatment Plant thence conveyed by a distribution system to the place of use for municipal and domestic purposes to serve Sierra Pacific Power Company's Service area as described on record in the State Engineer's office.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of water heretofore granted under Article V of the Truckee River Agreement, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Article V of the Truckee River Agreement. The total diversion under any certificates issued under Permits 43675, 44589 and 44590, and the points of diversion set forth in Article V of the Truckee River Agreement as incorporated in the Truckee River Final Decree shall not exceed 40.0 c.f.s., nor 28959.1 acre-feet annually.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
