CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Antelope Well) through a drilled well, windmill and trough for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 21, T.34N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 21 bears N. 45° 00' E., a distance of 2,366.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.009 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 22, 1983

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 431 feet deep, 8 inch diameter, via an "Arrow Motor" windmill, thence conveyed by 400 feet of polyethylene pipe to a stockwatering trough 30 inches high, 18 feet in diameter, with a concrete bottom containing 3,500 gallons of water where 1,000 head of cattle water within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
