CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and troughs for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 4, T.37N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 4 bears S. 62° 56' 38" E., a distance of 2,503.51 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.009 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 21, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 540 feet deep, 8 inch casing to 63 feet, then 6 inch casing to 540 feet deep, via a pump, thence conveyed by 1320 feet of 1 inch pipeline to six 500 gallon troughs where 300 head of cattle water within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
