CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 33, T.32N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 33 bears S. 5° 11' 14" E., a distance of 2,178.92 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.016 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 26, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 120 feet deep, 6 inch casing, thence conveyed by 20 feet of 1-1/4 inch pipeline to a 4' x 2' x 12' stockwatering trough where 500 head of cattle water within all of Section 33, T.32N., R.54E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
