CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, windmill pump and distribution system for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 13, T.32N., R.35E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 13 bears N. 86° 12' E., a distance of 571.5 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0155 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 8, 1983

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 150 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via an Aeromotor windmill and pump jack also powered by a 5 H.P. motor, thence conveyed by pipelines to a 12 foot diameter 500 gallon stockwatering trough where 500 head of cattle water within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
