CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John P. Davis, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring through a natural spring for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 19, T.14N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 29, T.14N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 45° 44' 09" E., a distance of 10,949.76 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Sario Livestock Co., a partnership
Post-office address: Gardnerville, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.012 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 5,000 sheep
Period of use, from: November 1st to August 14th of the following year of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 6, 1985

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of an unnamed spring where 5,000 sheep water within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 19, T.14N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
