CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard D. Moser, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River through an intake structure, piping and distribution system for Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 7 bears N. 39° 28' E., a distance of 3,015.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Date of priority of appropriation February 8, 1864

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of an intake structure, piping, Glendale Treatment Plant, thence conveyed by a pipeline distribution system to supply Sierra Pacific Power Company customers for municipal purposes located within the Sierra Pacific Power Company's service area which is on record in the State Engineer's Office.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and manner and place of use of Claim No. 619 of the Truckee River Decree, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim No. 619.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
