CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Tin Shed Well) through a drilled well, windmill and stockwatering trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 4 Section 5, T.33N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 6, T.33N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 79° 43' 15" W., a distance of 5,996.24 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Elko Land and Livestock Company
Post-office address: Carlin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.011 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 350 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 18, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 50 feet deep, 8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a windmill, pump jack and Lister motor, thence the water is conveyed via 30 feet of 1-1/2 inch pipeline to a trough 30' x 2' x 2' deep where 350 head of cattle water within Lot 4, Section 5, T.33N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
