CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Mack Farm Well) through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering trough for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 15, T.33N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 15 bears S. 73° 12' 56" E., a distance of 5,159.82 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Elko Land and Livestock Company  
Post-office address Carlin, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation August 18, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 106 feet deep, 8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump and motor, thence the water is conveyed by 100 feet of 1-1/2 inch pipeline to a trough 20 feet in diameter and 2 feet deep where 500 head of cattle water within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 15, T.33N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
