CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bruce Scott, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 3, T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 3 bears S. 59° 44' 11" E., a distance of 842.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00094 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 30 head of cattle  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

\* Date of priority of appropriation September 17, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 181 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 1 H.P. submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed to watering troughs where 30 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 3, T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

\* This certificate changes the point of diversion and manner of use of a portion of Permit 27767, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 27767.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
