CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bruce R. Scott, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Monument Well) through a drilled well, windmill, pump and stockwatering trough for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T.8N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 6 bears N. 86° 33' E., a distance of 1,653 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ray Okelberry
Post-office address: Goshen, Utah
Amount of appropriation: 0.1203 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1850 head of cattle and 10,000 sheep
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 2, 1982

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 164 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 10' diameter fan, windmill and gasoline engine and pump jack, thence the water is conveyed to a 40,000 gallon storage tank and then to an 80 foot trough and a 10 foot in diameter watering ring where 1850 head of cattle and 10,000 sheep water within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 6, T.8N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
