CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dale Aslett, Owner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 2, T.42N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 1, T.42N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 71° 30' 30" E., a distance of 5,714.91 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Circle A Construction, Inc.
Post-office address: Twin Falls, Idaho
Amount of appropriation: 0.65 c.f.s., but not to exceed 10.96 million gallons per season
Period of use, from April 1st to September 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 12, 1977

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by a drilled well, thence piped 300 feet by a 3 inch pipe to a pond and heavy media plant where the water is used for milling purposes within portions of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, W 1/2 SW 1/4 of Section 1; SE 1/4 NE 1/4, E 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 2, all in T.42N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
