CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Laurence Montero, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source

through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 1, T.41N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 13, T.41N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 15° 15' W., a distance of 7,525.0 feet

situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0374 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,200 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 6, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 100 feet deep, 8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed 1/2 mile by 1-1/4" pipeline to two 16' watering troughs where 1,200 head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, S 1/2 SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4, E 1/2 NW 1/4 SW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 and N 1/2 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 1, T.41N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
