CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Gary W. Holler, Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 18, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 18 bears S. 19° 11' 36" W., a distance of 1,386.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.5 c.f.s., but not to exceed 75.2652 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation September 10, 1954

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and turbine pump thence to distribution system where the water is used for approximately 17,400 municipal services within the City of North Las Vegas Service Area.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 15796, Certificate 7918, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 15796, Certificate 7918.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
