CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank Shields, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (White Sage Flat Well #4586) through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 36, T.29N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 36 bears N. 3° 41' 00" W., a distance of 1,490.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bureau of Land Management, Winnemucca District (1/2 interest); Ceresola Bros. (1/2 interest)
Post-office address: Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.03 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 735 head of cattle, 255 sheep, 151 horses
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from a drilled well, 250 feet deep, 8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a gas powered pump, thence the water is conveyed to a stockwatering trough 30' x 2' deep where 735 head of cattle, 255 sheep and 151 horses water within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 36, T.29N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
